I _____ solemnly swear: I will uphold the constitution, codes, rules, resolutions, and ordinances of the Quapaw Nation; I will maintain order the Quapaw Nation Tribal Court; I will demonstrate the utmost respect to the Quapaw Nation Tribal Court judges and officers; I will respect and honor Quapaw tradition, culture, and beliefs; I will practice with honesty, not misleading the judge or jury by a false statement of fact or law; I will not counsel for any suit or proceeding which appears to be unjust; I will conduct my duties in a manner that is to the highest degree of ethical and moral standards; and I will be guided at all times by quest for truth and justice.

At the time the application for admission the Bar is filed, the applicant shall also provide the following additional documents:

1. An official, original certificate of good standing issued by the bar of the highest court of any state of the United States or the District Court of Columbia dated no more the 90 calendar days prior to the date of application to the Quapaw Tribal Court Bar.
2. Sign and date # 17 “Consent to Jurisdiction” of the Quapaw Tribal Court Under Rule 9 of the ordinance regulating the practice of law in the Quapaw Tribal Court.
3. A \$50.00 check or money order made payable to the Quapaw Tribal Court Bar Association This amount includes a non-refundable twenty dollars (\$20.00) application fee and thirty dollars (\$30.00) annual membership fee.

****Pro Hac Vice* fee is twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) per case filing. Make all money orders or checks payable to the Quapaw Tribal Court Bar Association. ***

*** All renewal fees are due by Jan 31st of each year. A reminder letter will be mailed out the first of December every year. ***

*** If renewal fees are not paid from February 1 to December 31 come the next year the attorney will have to reapply to the Quapaw Tribal Court Bar. ***
