Before you begin completing this application, make sure you meet all the requirements below:

- You are an enrolled member of the Quapaw Nation <u>eligible for services</u>
- You are a high school or GED graduate
- You have been admitted to an accredited college, university, vocational or graduate school
- You understand that a complete application and all supporting documents must be postmarked/emailed/faxed/placed in drop box by July 31, 2021 to be eligible for Summer 2021 semester funding.

Please note that regardless of which option you choose to send your application, it is your responsibility to make sure Quapaw Nation Higher Education has received your application and that all information (including phone numbers, mailing addresses, and email addresses) are up-to-date and correct on your application.



NOTICE OF UPDATE OF PROCESSING PROCEDURE FOR QNHE FUNDING:

Due to an increase in the number of incorrect addresses and USPS issues, Quapaw Nation Higher Education has updated the order of the application/check processing procedure.

The updated procedure is as follows:

- 1. QNHE receives your application;
- 2. QNHE emails you and confirms that <u>you</u> sent the application, confirms your mailing address where you want your check sent, and confirms the number of credit hours you are taking for the semester.
- 3. You, the student, must reply to the email to confirm or correct those the items. <u>Your application will not be processed until you do so.</u>
- 4. QNHE processes your application once we have received your confirmation reply.
- 5. QNHE will send you an email informing you that your application has been processed and the check has mailed.
- 6. Because we are confirming everything beforehand, students must wait the full 30 days to receive their checks before QNHE can proceed with a stop-payment or issue a new check.

REMINDER...COMPLETE APPLICATION AND ALL SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS MUST BE POSTMARKED BY LY 31, 2021.

Benefits / Payments

Students accepted for funding through the Quapaw Nation Higher Education Program will be awarded \$150.00 per credit hour up to a maximum of \$2,250.00 for fall and spring semesters, and \$900.00 for summer semesters.

IF A STUDENT DROPS HOURS, HE OR SHE WILL EITHER PAY THE QUAPAW NATION HIGHER EDUCATION PROGRAM BACK APPROPRIATE MONIES OR HAVE SUBSEQUENT HIGHER EDUCATION AWARDS REDUCED BY SAID AMOUNT.

FOR EXAMPLE: IF A STUDENT RECEIVES AN AWARD FOR \$1,500.00 FOR 10 CREDIT HOURS AND HE OR SHE DROPS OR CHANGES TO AN AUDIT A THREE CREDIT CLASS, HE OR SHE MUST EITHER REFUND QUAPAW NATION HIGHER EDUCATION \$450.00 OR HAVE THE NEXT FUNDED SEMESTER'S AWARD REDUCED BY \$450.00.

Please allow up to 30 days for your check to be processed. Calling Quapaw Nation Higher Education or accounting staff inquiring as to the status of your check before the 30 days creates a setback for the departments in processing your check.

Before submitting transcripts, make sure all Quapaw Nation funded semesters are indicated by course grades for those funded semesters.

For example, if you were awarded Quapaw Nation education funds for the Spring 2021 semester, make sure the transcript submitted with this Summer 2021 application indicates your Spring 2021 semester grades.

SIX SIMPLE TIPS for

SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETING YOUR HIGEHR EDUCATION APPLICATION

- 1. Don't wait until the last minute to turn in your application. If something is missing, and you cannot provide the missing items by the deadline, the application will be considered incomplete.
- 2. If sending your application via regular mail, *please have them weigh the envelope*. If your application is received after the deadline because it was returned to you and you had to resend it, *it is still late and will not be accepted*.
- 3. If sending your application **via fax**, please write "Attention Higher Education" on the cover sheet.
- 4. If emailing your application, you must send all items as either .doc, .docx, or PDFs. *NO zip files will be accepted*.
- 5. If turning in your application in person, please make sure that you go over the checklist before coming into the Tribal Administration offices. *It is your responsibility to make sure you have included all required items*.
